Inception

"Pratishruti Cancer and Palliative Trust, Dibrugarh" is a nonprofit foundation which serves in the field of cancer and palliative care. Its objective is to empower the community with a scientific approach to beat and fight cancer. A group of dedicated people comprising of cancer survivors, family members of affected patients, conscious motivated citizens of all walks of life including doctors, nurses and paramedics, came together to give birth to a vision of improving the status of those living with cancer and maintain their quality of life till last breath and beyond by palliative care. With this bold vision as guiding principle- "PRATISHRUTI" was incepted on 15th December, 2017.

Vision and Mission

Cancer is the second most common cause of death in India after cardiovascular diseases. This is a disease which is inherently associated with tremendous amount of suffering - physical, mental and social. Understandably, it can not be treated by doctors or hospital alone, but requires care by family, friends and community. According to Indian Council of Medical Research data, India had 14 lakhs Cancer patients in 2012. Also one out of 10 individuals are likely to develop cancer after the age of 75 years. India lost nearly 6.7 billion USD in 2012 due to cancer, amounting to 0.36 per cent of the total GDP. Assam has very poor infra- structure for comprehensive cancer care which add to more mortality morbidity and financial stress.

Pratishruti will coordinate, collaborate, support in all aspect of cancer control and offer palliative care to reduce the impact of the disease on survival, function, and quality of life; more specifically for disadvantaged section of society with proper distribution of resources.

Aims & Objectives

- To initiate cancer awareness programmes on risk factors of cancer which may be a part of social practices like chewing of tobacco, smoking, alcohol intake, early marriage etc.
- To remove social stigma/ misconception, fear related to cancer.
- To sensitize the community about various signs, symptoms and means of detection and treatment.
- To take steps for the early detection of cancer such as screening camps
- To provide, palliative care which includes physical, psychosocial, spiritual support for patients with
- chronic pain, cancer and other life-threatening illness

- To help in supply of palliative drugs, essential medicine and paramedical manpower for caring the patients.
- To disseminate cancer related information including Government schemes, initiatives and regarding various financial benefits to patients and families.
- To organize lectures, conferences, seminars, workshops and other training courses on screening/ palliative care for doctors, nurses and other health workers.
- To sensitize the public to participate in community palliative care.

Pratishruti Helpline number

On 15th December 2018, two Dedicated Helpline numbers were introduced (6001830079 & 6001688341). These cancer helpline numbers are second in Assam after Deepsikha Foundation with a ready answering desk. The aim of the helpline number is to provide the easiest way of reaching out to volunteer services of Pratishruti. This includes social, psychological, emotional, financial coordination and treatment support. Patient and Caregiver may call this numbers seeking information about cancer treatment, guidance, doctor appointment, Palliative Care, registration for Home Care etc. We have a panel of Doctors across the cities who are committed to offer free consultation and guidance. Helpline numbers are lifeline numbers to all cancer patients requiring diverse kinds of help. Till today hundreds of calls have been received and guidance provided through this helpline numbers.

Pratishruti Home Care Project is first of its kind initiative in the North East. This started on 15th Dec 2018. The palliative Home visit/consultation/ care is completely free in Dibrugarh and neighbouring districts.

Home-based palliative care services are becoming increasingly popular with care being taken to the deorstep of the patient. Ideally, this is where people are most comfortable at the end of their lives, surrounded by their loved ones. It is also well suited to conditions in India where a family member is usually available and willing to nurse the sick person. Pratishruti Palliative Home Care is a community level project having a vision of complete voluntary participation of the people, for the people, by the people and through the people approach to provide Palliative Care Service at door step.

Pratishruti Palliative Home Care team consists of Doctors, Nurses and Social Workers trained in Palliative Care and are willing to give volunteer service.

The Year long Activities

Cancer Screening Camps

In the span of 2 years, PRATISHRUTI along with Assam Medical College and Hospital, Assam Cancer Care Foundation and Non Communicable Disease Program of National Health Mission of Govt. of India was involved in organizing over 35 Cancer Screening Camps in Block PHC and Health Centers in Dibrugarh District. 7 Cancer Screening camps were organized in association with Deepsikha Foundation, Lions Club of Brahmaputra Valley, All Assam Students Union, Dibrugarh Zila Mahila Samiti, Shruti Shilpi Samaj and other NGOs in Dibrugarh. In these camps, around 4000 people were screened. The patients suspected and detected with Cancer in these camps were given proper counselling and guidance for further investigations, treatment and follow up.



Cancer Awareness Programme

Oral, Breast, Cervical, Esophagus, Gall Bladder and other Tobacco related cancer cases are increasing in Assam and the North East. There are many risk factors which are associated with cancer. Importance was also given to Cancer Awareness lectures, rallies by joining hands with other organizations in various colleges, clubs, villages, etc. A Total of 40 Cancer Awareness Programmes were organized by PRATISHRUTI in Dibrugarh Distict.

Cancer & Palliative Care Support Desk at AMCH

As a part of the project, with the help of The Principal, Assam Medical College & Hospital, a 'Cancer & Palliative Care Support Desk' was started in Cancer Ward of AMCH. A team of Volunteers was available in the support desk to provide all types of help to the cancer patients and their family including management of Bed sores. 330 patients were registered with PRATISHRUTI in AMCH Cancer Ward Help Desk. Due to reasons beyond control the Help Desk in the cancer Ward of AMC had to be discontinued. However, the same services are being continued through our registered office.



Training Programme

Several Palliative Care Training courses were conducted for Doctors, Nurses & Volunteers.

- a) 27th January, 2018: Symposium on Palliative Care for Volunteers, Nurses and Doctors.
- b) 8th April, 2018: Palliative Care hands-on Training.
- c) 24th February, 2019: Orientation and Training in Palliative Care with hands-on Training supported by Department of Radiation Oncology, AMCH; Department of Psychiatry, AMCH & Guwahati Pain and Palliative Care Society.
- d) 9th October, 2019: A Sensitization programme on Palliative Care supported by Lions Club of Brahmaputra Valley.
- e) 20th October, 2019: Cancer Awareness Programme" for ANM, ASHA Supervisors and ASHA Workers supported by Dibrugarh District Health Society.
- f) 18th November, 2019: Seminar on "Role of Women in Pallative Home Care" supported by Dibrugarh Zila Mahila Samiti.

Resources: The core strength

Pratishruti has been providing essential humanitarian palliative and cancer care services to the community by focussing on making its project and services self sustainable. The sustainability of our project can primarily be attributed to 2 major factors.

- · Free or unpaid services- consultative services of doctors, on ground and execution services by volunteers / nurses/ other paramedical workers.
- · Community support through donor contribution and joint ventures with other supporting organizations.

Pratishruti is also proud to have been invited at the 27th International Conference of Indian Association of Palliative care to be held at Guwahati February 2020 to present its operational model - highlighting the underlying factors for execution of essential services in a unique way.

New Announcement for 2019-2020

State Level Cancer Care / Awarness Campaign:

Pratishruti initiated a State Level Cancer Care / Awarness campaign which was formally flagged off on 20th October, 2019, with a "Cancer Awarness Programme." It was to train ANM, ASHA workers and ASHA supervisors with focus on Awarness on Cancer, Breast Cancer and Cancer Care. This programme was supported by Dibrugarh District Health Society. The aim of the programme is to make awareness on common cancers in Assam, risk factors, early diagnosis by cancer screening process for those without a disease, cancer care basics such as diagnostics, types of treatment for those with disease and undergoing treatment and palliative care for advance stage of cancer. It would be conducted in different places of Assam with our supporting organizations and media partners, which will cover the free consultation of patients of that particular locality by our panel of experts. To enhance the impact of the program Rallies, Awarness walks, runs or interactine programs and meetings will be organized using educative materials, lectures and through media. Cancer Screening programme will also be organized.
